3. How often do you find yourself tempted to define yourself and others in terms of accomplishments, abilities, and reputations?
4. Pastor Joey said, "It is when we are most *like* God that we are tempted to think we *are* God." In what areas of your life are you tempted to act as if you are God?
5. How does praying this prayer free you from the temptation to define yourself and others in terms of accomplishments, abilities, and reputations?
6. What has most challenged you from this sermon series? What has most comforted you?
