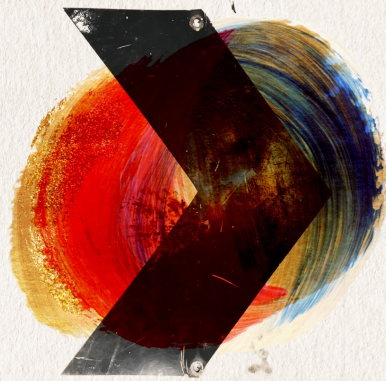


# GREATER THAN

## Sermon Discussion Questions

### *Greater Confidence – Hebrews 2:10-18 – Oct. 28, 2018*

- When have you ever felt like an imposter – like you didn't belong, and people were going to find out the truth about you?
- What things tend to give you a sense of confidence in yourself?
- The writer talks about Jesus bringing “many sons to glory” (v10). How does God display his glory through us right now? How is God working out his glory in our lives?
- Jesus identifies with us in our weakness (11-14a): Jesus knows everything that it is to be human, and everything about us – yet he is not ashamed to call us his brothers (and sisters). How does that encourage you and give you confidence to be honest about yourself?
- Jesus identifies with us in death (14-16): Jesus experiences death to deliver us. How does death (physical death, things that feel like death) hold us in slavery to fear? How does Jesus' death for you give you confidence and hope?
- Jesus identifies with us in temptation (17-18): Jesus suffered in temptation in every way we are. Why do we find it hard to believe Jesus really knows our temptations? How does he help us as we experience temptations?
- This week, look for the things you tend to place your confidence in (your experience, strength, grades, success, knowledge, friends, finances, health, looks, etc.). Thank the Father for the good things he's given you, but also ask him to help you place your ultimate trust in Christ – who he is, what he's done, his eternal purposes.
