



Sermon Discussion Questions // Accidental Evangelism - Jonah 1:4-17

- Do you agree with Pastor Joey when he says “sometimes religious people make the worst missionaries”?
- Have you experienced your own sin causing “storms” in your life? How did you respond? How do you wish you had responded?
- Have you been caught in others’ “sin-storms”? How did you respond to them? How do you wish you had responded?
- Do you agree with Pastor Joey’s definition of sin, that sin is “self-sabotage”?
- Not every storm is caused by sin. How does your faith help you weather the storms that come your way simply because we live in a fallen world?
- Have you found yourself in a situation like Jonah, where you can’t face the consequences of your actions, so you mentally check out? What brought you out of it?
- Pastor Joey said spiritual sloth comes from resisting the demands that come with a relationship you’re in. When have you seen sloth manifest itself in your life?
- Have you found yourself to be “slothful” in your relationship with God, resisting the demands that a relationship with God places on your life?
- What do you do to combat sloth in your relationship with God? With others?
- Jonah’s deepest identity is his nationality, his ethnicity. What is yours? If you could only describe yourself by association with one group, what would it be?
- How has God surprised you through this study in Jonah?
