



Sermon Discussion Questions

Our Own Greatest Enemies - Jonah 3:5 - 4:4

- When have you, or someone you know, been in a situation where you got what you wanted, only to realize it wasn't what was best for you? Have you ever experienced the realization that in some ways you were Your Own Worst Enemy?
- What does real repentance look like? When have you repented of something? What did you do? Is there anything God might be calling you to repent of right now? Who are the people that you allow to speak into your life?
- How have you seen God change you or someone else radically? Have you ever had a hard time believing that someone has changed or could change? Have you ever had to look at someone differently because of what God showed you about that person?
- Jonah's resentment shows that he loved something more than God's grace and kindness. What is it that makes you really angry or resentful about what God is doing or allowing? Are there any people, or groups of people, you would have a hard time wanting to see in the kingdom of God?
- God's grace to us in Christ gives us an identity and security that nothing can threaten. Ask God to help you grow in grace that trusts and obeys him, and produces joy, love, and peace for you and others.
