Prodigal Prophets and God's Compassion // Jonah 4:5-11

- Have you had an experience of wishing God's judgment on someone else? Or resentment that God was being good to *that* person? What was behind those feelings?
- In what ways do I tend to measure God's goodness by what I think I deserve?
- Why do we struggle to see losses, difficulties, disappointments or hardships as expressions of God's grace to us?
- How thankful am I for Jesus' ultimate, undeserved, loving, compassion for me?
- How can I be more willing to allow the Holy Spirit to open my eyes to a lost world -- and do something about it?
- In what areas am I running from God's wise and loving instruction to me?
- How could I allow the Holy Spirit to move me from sloth/indifference to compassionate action on behalf of others?
- Who am I burdened for? To whom am I reaching out with truth and grace of Jesus?
