- In what ways have you found that statement ("you can't become what you can't imagine") to be true in your life?
- How did Timothy exemplify the "mind of Christ"? What parallels does Paul draw between his description of Timothy and his admonition to the church at Philippi?
- Who models for you what the mind of Christ looks like in your daily experience, in your context?
- How did Epaphroditus exemplify the "life of Christ"? What parallels does Paul draw between his description of Epaphroditus and his description of Jesus?
- Who models for you what the life of Christ looks like in your daily experience, in your context?
- Who or what fuels your imagination as you think about how your life could become more like Jesus' life?

• Are you close enough to other people of faith that you can see the life of Jesus and the mind of Jesus at work in them?
