



Sermon Discussion Questions

Gospel Partnership // Philippians 1:1-8

- What sparks joy in you? If you were to pare your life down to the most important things, what would those be?
- An 'evangel' in the ancient world was the announcement of important news with profound implications for life. What is the 'evangel' Paul that summarizes in Philippians 1:2? What implications does it have for your life?
- What gives you your sense of identity? Look at how Paul talks about himself and the believers in Philippi in 1:1, 6). How does partnership in the gospel change the way we see ourselves and others?
- What frightens or worries you? Look at the confident assurance we have in the gospel (1:6). How does that impact the way you face disappointment, trials, or uncertainty?
- What expressions of closeness and care do you see in 1:3-8? How does the partnership in Christ create close relational bonds? How has the gospel drawn you close to someone you wouldn't normally connect with?
- Who around you needs to know the good news of Jesus? How will you reflect the joy and life of Christ to them this week?
