



Sermon Discussion Questions

Gospel Proclamation // Psalm 103

- David tells himself to praise the Lord. He is reminding himself who the Lord is and telling himself “Don’t forget.” What helps you remember not to forget? What is David reminding himself to not forget?
- We see David’s declaration of God’s character and actions toward us. How does reflecting on God’s character and attributes orient us to what is real and true? What do you see about God’s character in Psalm 103 that you need to be reminded of?
- David doesn’t just know what God has done in his life, but also what he’s done in history. How does Jesus fulfill and extend these expressions of God’s character and promises in the gospel?
- Pastor Jeff talked about the “bad sermons” we sometimes preach to ourselves. What do you talk to your soul about? What bad or false gospels do you sometimes believe?
- How does the truth of the real gospel of Jesus encourage you in your walk with God? In what areas do you want to reflect more of the character of God here – compassion, mercy, patience, kindness, faithfulness, forgiveness, etc.? What will do to move in the direction?
