



Sermon Discussion Questions

The Call to Worship // Psalm 95:1-7a

- Describe a time you found yourself unexpectedly changed by something you'd been doing regularly.
- Do you agree with Pastor Joey's comment that the way we choose to worship forms us into a certain kind of worshiper? Why or why not?
- If you grew up attending a church, what kind of "liturgy" did that church have?
- Pastor Joey defined "liturgy" as *the work the people are gathered to do*. In your opinion, what is the "work" Faith Church gathers to do each Sunday?
- Have you wondered why Faith starts its services with a Call to Worship?
- Pastor Joey repeatedly said "God calls, we respond, and that changes us." What implications does that have for the way you worship?
- Read Psalm 95:1-7. What's the main command in these verses? Once we obey that main command, what are we supposed to do next?
- How does your worship personally shape you?
- What has changed in your opinion of Faith's worship since hearing this sermon?
- Pastor Joey said that when we come to worship with God's people, we are not just entering the place of God's presence, but the arena of God's activity. When you show up on a Sunday morning, do you expect God to act?
- How would you know if He did? Are you content if He acts in small ways and not large ways?
