



Sermon Discussion Questions

Fallen Worship // Colossians 1:15-23

- Have you ever had a “what happened?” moment? What were the circumstances surrounding it?
- Pastor Joey said that we’re studying Colossians 1:15-23 to “put Christmas in context”, so that we understand how the baby Jesus fits into the whole story of the Bible. What have you learned so far?
- What theories have people you know come up with to explain why the world doesn’t work the way we want it to?
- What kind of things do they do in their lives and in their communities to try to fix that brokenness?
- How does the Apostle Paul describe the origins of the world’s brokenness? (Hint: look at Romans 1.)
- Do you agree with Pastor Joey, that the root of all the problems we see in the world today is a problem of worship? Why or why not?
- Pastor Joey said that your heart works like a compass needle, always spinning to align itself with what’s most attractive at the moment. What is most attractive to your heart right now?

- What do you do to keep God as most attractive in your life?
- Look at verses 18 and 20. What happens when we worship something other than God?
- Can you identify how, in your life, your problems come from fallen worship?
- How many of the things you worship will pick up the slack if you fail to worship them completely?
- How has Jesus given himself to you to win back your heart's affections?
- What are you going to do this week to continue to live with Jesus at the center of your universe?
