Pray With Me // Psalm 73

- How has the transFORMATION series changed the way you understand our worship at Faith Church?
- Have you ever experienced a crisis of faith? What led you into it? What led you out of it?
- If you're currently experiencing a crisis of faith or doubts about God's goodness, what drives you to continue showing up for worship and small group discussions like this one?
- Asaph's "spiritual vertigo" came as a result of not being able to make sense of what he saw around him with what he believed to be true about God. When has that happened to you?
- Describe a time in your life when you felt as Asaph does in Psalm 73:12, "All in vain have I kept my heart clean and washed my hands in innocence."

- How does life look differently when seen through an “outside the sanctuary” perspective versus an “inside the sanctuary” perspective?
- When in your life has prayer reordered the way you saw the world?
- When in your life has prayer reoriented your understanding of the end, of the purpose of life?
- When in your life has prayer reformed your emotions, shaping them to respond appropriately to God?
- Pastor Joey said that “prayer together holds our worlds together.” When have you found prayer helping you make sense of your world?
- Do you approach God as an object of adoration, or speculation? How does that approach shape the way you relate to God?
- How do you need to approach congregational prayer differently after discussing this sermon? Who will help you do that?
