



Sermon Discussion Questions

Blessed To Be A Blessing // Psalm 67

- Can you think of a momentous occasion in your life where someone spoke a benediction over you? What was that experience like?
- Does the thought of receiving undeserved blessings from God make you feel uncomfortable?
- In Psalm 67 we the Psalmist reflect on God's blessing in verse 1, and turns to praise in verses 2-7. When was a time that God's blessing in your life drove you to praise him?
- Have you ever been tempted to think that the good things in your life (job, possessions, status, family) were a result of your own doing, and not a result of God's grace and goodness?
- How can you purposefully remind yourself of God's character when you consider his blessings?
- What part of the truth of Gospel do you need to reinforce in your own heart this week?
- What are some upcoming situations where you could speak a benediction over someone close to you?
- Read and reflect on some of these benedictions found in scripture:
