



Sermon Discussion Questions

Offerings // Psalm 66

- Pastor Jeff said that gifts are a way we show honor, reflect value, and express appreciation, and demonstrate thoughtfulness. When has a gift you've given or received really reflected that?
- When have you received (or given) a gift that wasn't a very good expression of someone's real value?
- How does giving to church connect to giving to God if he doesn't really need anything?
- How do money and possessions compete for our awe, love, trust, significance? How does our giving to God reflect his greatness -- his glory, majesty, priority in our lives?
- How are we tempted to display our greatness or goodness through giving? How can you give in a way that points people to God and not you?
- The Psalmist sees how good God has been to him, and that prompts a response of generously giving back. How has God been amazingly good to you?
- Pastor Jeff said that by definition a sacrifice costs us something. How has your awareness of God's goodness led you to lavish generosity?

- The Psalmist recounts God's grace in his deliverance and rescue of his people. How is God's goodness to undeserving people reflected in your giving?
- How does this encourage or challenge you in your financial priorities and giving? What do you want God to help you do differently as a result?
