Confession of Sin

Pray together to confess your sins to God. Consider using a prayer like this:

God our Father, we confess that our hands are stained with iniquity, that our lips have spoken lies, that our tongues have muttered wickedness.

We confess that our feet run to evil, that we are swift to shed innocent blood, that our thoughts are thoughts of iniquity, that desolation and destruction are in our wake.

We do not know the way of peace, we have made our paths crooked, and know no peace.

We confess our sins to you now.

End by acknowledging God's mercy and realizing that he has forgiven your sins in Christ Jesus.

Father, your hand is not shortened that it cannot save. Forgive us, cleanse us within, make us whiter than snow, in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Hear the Good News!

Remember and believe the words the Apostle John writes in his first letter:

"If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Know that because of your faith in Christ, you are forgiven, and be at peace.
