Confession of Sin

Pray together to confess your sins to God. Consider using a prayer like this:

Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your name. Amen.

End by acknowledging God's mercy and realizing that he has forgiven your sins in Christ Jesus.

May Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, through Jesus Christ our Lord, and strengthen us to live in the power of the Holy Spirit, all our days. Amen.

Hear the Good News!

Remember the words the Apostle Paul writes in 1st Corinthians 6:11, "*Such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of God.*"

Know that because of your faith in Jesus Christ, you are forgiven, and be at peace.

Pray Together

Spend some time together in prayer. Thank God for his salvation in Jesus. Thank God for his sustaining grace. Thank him for the medical professionals who are caring for us during this pandemic. Thank him for the health that you are currently experiencing, and pray against sickness.
