Confession of Sin

Pray together to confess your sins to God. Consider using a prayer like this:

And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed.
John 3:19-20, ESV

Father, we confess that sometimes we choose darkness because we enjoy our sin and we're not ready to give it up. We can fear that confessing sin will lead to accountability, and we're not sure we're that serious about giving it up. Far too often, we both hate and love our sin, and we justify our sinful choices to ourselves and others. But Jesus makes it safe to be honest with ourselves and you about our sin.

Allow time for personal reflection and confession. End by acknowledging God's mercy and realizing that he has forgiven your sins in Christ Jesus.

Father, your hand is not shortened that it cannot save. Forgive us, cleanse us within, make us whiter than snow, in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

Hear the Good News!

God forgives us because Jesus died for our sins, so we can rejoice in the reassuring words from Romans 6:5-7. Read them aloud now.

Praise God, we are forgiven and promised an eternal resurrection! Know that because of your faith in Jesus Christ, you are forgiven, and be at peace.
