What Does God Require? // An Overview of the Book of Micah

- We all reflect other people's influences parents, friends, siblings, community. How are other people's values, perspectives, and ways of doing life reflected in you?
- When have you made a conscious decision to not be influenced by others to go a different direction?
- Read Micah 6:8. God tells his people what we should reflect of him in our lives. Why do you think Micah focuses on these three things?
- God is Just. What are some ways that justice gets perverted in our culture, our community, or in our world? God consistently tells his people to speak out and act on behalf of the poor, the weak and the vulnerable when they are treated unfairly. What could that look like in our world?
- God is Merciful. How has God shown you kindness, goodness, faithfulness when you didn't deserve it? Think of the (kinds of) people you're not sure you want to see God bless or show mercy. Why are they a struggle for you? How could you reflect God's goodness to them?
- God is Awesome. How does God's power, glory, righteousness humble us? What's the difference between being humble about our opinions and believing that all opinions are equally good? In what areas do you need God to help you to grow in humility?
