



Sermon Discussion Questions

The Lord Delights in Steadfast Love // Micah 7:18-20

- Pastor Jeff said that neither begrudging kindness nor fear of punishment can really change our hearts. Do you agree? What has prompted significant change in you?
- In Micah 7:18 and 20 God talks about his “steadfast love” (or mercy or lovingkindness). How have you experienced God's steadfast love in your life? Where has God shown not just mercy but patient, enduring, undeserved goodness to you?
- God pardons our iniquities (twistedness) and passes over our transgression (active rebellion). Who angers, annoys, or has wronged you? How can you show them God's faithful love?
- God doesn't hold on to his anger, but he delights in steadfast love. What negative emotions or responses are you holding on to? How does God's grace help you let go of those things?
- God has trampled down our sins in Christ and cast them away. What sins or negative patterns are you putting behind you, not going back to?
- Spend some time reflecting on how Jesus has demonstrated and guaranteed all these promises – pardon, pity, power, and promise-keeping. Then thank and praise God for his steadfast love!
