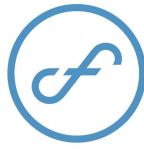




Sermon Discussion Questions

God's Tough Love // Micah 6:9-16

- When have you gotten away with something that you shouldn't have?
- When have you had to say hard things to someone to set them straight -- or when has someone had to say hard things to you?
- Look at the kinds of sins God convicts his people of (10-12, 16a) – acquiring wealth unjustly, fraud, dishonesty, violence, idolatry. How are those sins reflected in our society or in your life?
- What painful consequences does God say he will bring because of his people's sins (13-15, 16b)? Why does God bring this kind of pain to his people?
- What is God's goal in warning and disciplining his people (v9)?
- When have you suffered for sinful choices or habits? What did you learn from it? How did you change?
- How did Jesus take on the devastation, rejection, and shame we deserve? How does Jesus' suffering in our place change your attitude toward the things you need to change in your life?
