Sermon Discussion Questions

To Be Let In // John 10:1-10

- We've probably all felt at some time that we're on the outside looking in. Do you agree? What has that looked like for you?
- Jesus uses the common biblical image of us being like sheep. From what you know about sheep, what does that tell you about yourself, what you're like, and what you need?
- Jesus calls his sheep by name (John 10:3). Do you ever wonder if Jesus really *knows* you and what you need? Where do you need the reminder that he knows you individually?
- Jesus warns/reminds us that the world is full of thieves and robbers who want to steal and destroy (John 10:1, 8-9). Seldom do thieves and robbers tell is that's what they are. How does the world offer us green pastures and abundant life? How do those offers end up leading to emptiness and death?
- Jesus' sheep hear his voice, and they won't follow a stranger (John 10:5, 8). What "voices" or inputs get your time and attention, especially in this season? How are you listening to Jesus?

- Jesus says he has come to bring us abundant life (John 10:10). Where you seeing Jesus' goodness in your life? Where are you struggling to see God's goodness?
- Jesus says his sheep will go in and out because he leads them (John 10:9). Who is Jesus leading you "out" to bring in?
