Redeemed In Unity // Philippians 2:1-11

- Do you find it more difficult to serve others or to be served? Why do you find that more difficult than the alternative?
- Pastor Jeff said, “to come together, we have to look Cross-ward.” What is it about the cross that brings us together?
- “Unity comes from using our privilege and advantage to serve others.” What is it I think I have a right to, that I struggle to let go of? What has God given to me or entrusted to me? How am I using it to serve others?
- Unity doesn't come from surrendering what's essential. But how many essentials do you have? What's your list of non-negotiables that everyone has to agree with you on in order to have unity?
- Unity comes from yielding my rights for the sake of others. Look what Christ was willing to give up. What have you given up to serve others?

- Jesus doesn't go to the cross for himself. Look at who he was willing to love. Who do you have a hard time loving? Pray for God to bless those people and soften your heart. How can you love them better?
