



Sermon Discussion Questions

Galatians 1:1-9 // No Other Gospel

- Have you ever misunderstood a story, or what someone told you, because you missed the context around the story? What happened when you learned the whole story?
- Pastor Joey asked us this question: “what is the gospel?” How would you answer that question?
- When you consider that the gospel is good news (not good advice), how does that change the way you think about the gospel?
- When you consider that the gospel is good news about Israel’s Messiah, how does that put the gospel into a bigger storyline?
- How does putting the gospel into that bigger storyline change the way you think about the gospel?
- Pastor Joey said “Jesus didn’t die to take you to heaven. He died to bring heaven back to you.” Do you agree? Why or why not?
- Galatians 1:3-5 says the gospel includes two big movements: 1) Jesus gave himself for your sins, and 2) Jesus rescued you from the present evil age. What happens if we focus on only one of those two and neglect the other?
- Which of those two big movements do you tend to focus on, at the expense of the other?
- What will you do this week, in your community, to live into your identity as children of God, citizens of a kingdom to come?
