



Director of Contemporary Worship

Overview

Lead the people of Faith Church in worship of God through contemporary worship, including planning, preparation, and execution of weekly in-person and online worship, as well as leading the worship teams and congregation as a whole.

Qualifications

- Believer in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and committed to the doctrine, mission, values, and bylaws of Faith Church
- Intimate, dynamic, and growing relationship with God through Christ
- Passion for leading people into worship of God
- Maintain healthy, God-honoring relationships with family and community
- Gifts and training in contemporary worship leading
- Relational and leadership ability to provide training, shepherding, and leading to worship team members
- Ability to select appropriate music and readings for the skill level of the worship team volunteers and for the spiritual formation of the congregation, and ultimately for the glory of God
- Thorough understanding of music and production technology and its role in enhancing worship both in-person and online

Responsibilities

Duties include, but not limited to:

- As part of the Faith Church staff team, own and implement the staff and church core values
- Plan, prepare, and execute in-person and online weekend contemporary services in collaboration with the preaching pastor
- Lead congregational worship for the contemporary services
- Recruit, train, and mentor volunteer worship leaders



- Plan music for the contemporary worship services, with an appreciation for the history and practice of worship at Faith Church
 - Faith appreciates both the depth of theology contained in many time-tested hymns and also appreciates the emotional resonance of many newer songs; however, theology is preferred before emotional expression
 - Faith is most at home stylistically with groups such as CityAlight and Shane & Shane
 - The goal of the worship service at Faith is to rehearse the gospel story line through song, Scripture, prayer, and preaching, such that individuals are drawn into deeper love for God through Christ, which forms individuals spiritually and shapes individuals into a congregation.
- Recruit, develop, and shepherd the contemporary worship team volunteers musically and spiritually
- Organize and lead worship team rehearsal, including planning and communication of worship transitions and spoken/service elements, worship team devotions and prayer, and communication and fellowship among team members
- Influence, resource, and equip student worship ministry and leadership
- Work with support staff on media and sound engineering for the contemporary services
- Organize and lead all-church services and special services, such as Good Friday, Christmas Eve, quarterly prayer and worship events, etc.
- Maintain a healthy collaborative relationship with all Faith Church ministries
- Provide support for worship music needs as they occur in any ministry of the church
- Oversee the budget for worship ministry
- Other duties as assigned
