



## Sermon Discussion Questions

Galatians 6:11-18 // In The Cross

- Why is the cross of Christ offensive to our pride?
- Paul refuses to place confidence in himself, his religious heritage, or his own moral endeavors. What do we/you tend to boast about or take confidence in?
- Look at Galatians 6:14. What does it mean to boast in the cross, and how does Paul's view of the cross shape the way he views the world?
- Read Galatians 6:12, 17. According to the Judaizers, what is the mark of a person who knows God? What is their motivation? How is this different than the motivation of Paul?
- What are "the marks of Jesus" that we as Christians might expect to bear?
- The way of the cross is one of humility and not pride. How does Paul's view of the cross lead to humility? What are some ways that you can cultivate humility in your life?
- Circumcision may not be a cause of division, but we separate over ethnic, political, or personal differences. How does the cross make unity possible among God's people?
- As we close out our study in Galatians, what are the main things you learned or were reminded of? How has your love for Jesus deepened? How has your love for others grown?
