Matthew 5:27-30 // Don't Look Now!

- Why do you think Jesus addresses the issue of lust?
- Why is this topic vital for us to understand in our present context?
- Why is it significant that Jesus refocuses all of these discussions of Old Testament laws back on to the heart of the person, rather than the letter of the law?
- Is Jesus anti-sex? How do you know? Is Jesus against men and women being sexually attracted to each other? What is Jesus really against?
- What's the significance of the word choice Jesus employs for "desire"?
- What's wrong with the desire to reduce a person down to a product to be used for your own purposes?
- How does lust show up in our lives?
- What's Jesus's method for rooting out lust? Is he being literal, metaphorical, or somewhere in between?
- How radically are you willing to deal with sin? How drastically are you willing to root out lust?
- How do you need to confess and repent of lust? Who can walk with you as you struggle to overcome these desires?
