## Sermon Discussion Questions

John 1:14-18 // Grace and Truth

- The more you get to know people, does your view of them tend to go up or go down? When has someone exceeded your expectations the more time you spent with them?
- John says that from Jesus' fullness we have all received grace. What does God's fullness mean? How do we experience God's fullness? When are you tempted to think there's a limit to God's goodness? When do you have a hard time seeing or believing in his fullness towards you?
- From God's fullness we have received "grace after grace" or fresh grace that replaces grace already received. How did you experience God's grace this week? This past year? What habits or practices will help you see and remember God's kindness and faithfulness?
- John seems to make a connection between Jesus' being full of "grace and truth" and God describing himself as "full of steadfast love and covenant loyalty" (Exod. 34:6). How does the continuity of God's gracious character encourage you? What does it suggest about God's faithfulness and your future?
- As we head towards Christmas, where do you want God to help you reflect his steadfast love and faithfulness?
