

## **Sermon Discussion Questions**

## ACTS 2:14-36 // THE SERMON

- Summarize the story of Acts so far. What has stood out to you from these first few stories?
- Have you ever found yourself in a state of "theological free-fall," spinning in zero-gravity looking for something solid to set your feet on?
- How might Peter's audience have felt as he reframed their entire understanding of how God is working in the world?
- How does Peter explain the phenomenon of the early Jesus-followers speaking in languages they haven't learned? Why is that important to his overall argument in this sermon?
- Since the idea of someone coming back from the dead is utterly implausible, how does Peter make the idea plausible to his hearers?
- What does it mean for Peter to claim that Jesus is the "Christ"?
- What does it mean for Peter to claim that Jesus is the "Lord"?
- Why are these claims important for the crowd to wrestle with?
- Are you at a place in your spiritual journey where you see Jesus as both Lord and Christ? Why or why not?
- How do you daily follow Jesus as the Christ and submit to him as the Lord?
