

Sermon Discussion Questions

ACTS 1:6-11 // THE KINGDOM

- When you think of "kingdom" what comes to mind?
- What makes Jesus' kingdom different from earthly kingdoms we're familiar with?
- Jesus' disciples are eager to see his kingdom arrive (v. 6). In what ways is Jesus' kingdom a reality now? In what ways are we still waiting for Jesus' Kingdom?
- Jesus tells his disciples they don't need to know all the details of what the Father is doing and how it will all work out (v. 7). Not knowing the future of our lives is actually a blessing how? When have you had to walk by faith, not knowing what was coming next? How did God guide and provide for you?
- Jesus says he will empower his disciples to be witnesses to his kingdom where they are and to the ends of the earth (v. 8). How have you experienced God's power? What would you tell people about what Jesus has done for you?
- Pastor Jeff said, "We are not passengers to Jesus' kingdom, we are partners in it." How has God helped you (or your life) be a witness for Him?
- The angels tell the disciples to stop staring up into heaven (v. 11). How do we focus on our eternal future in a way that makes a difference in our day-to-day lives?
- How do you want to witness the power of Jesus' life in you? In your relationships? In our world? What is your part in that?
