THIS WEEK'S SERMON DISCUSSION

Pastor Joey preached about Paul and Barnabas being "sent" as the first missionaries to a specific group of people with an intentional purpose. But Pastor Joey noted that doesn't mean the same thing in our cultural context. Paul and Barnabas were sent out as missionaries from a group of everyday missionaries who had already been "Gossipers of the Gospel." This group of people was already actively sharing the Gospel wherever they went. Sending Paul and Barnabas wasn't a break from the norm; it was just the next logical step.

The Acts of the Spirit GATHERING THE CHURCH

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That is because they only knew one reality: being an early Christian equaled being a missionary. Sharing the Gospel in challenging situations was a lifestyle for them. God has called us to a different time, with different circumstances. One of the challenges God has stewarded us is that we must work harder to live the way he intended us. Fueled by grace, we must intentionally develop a lifestyle of evangelism, or it won't happen.

The first step is to embrace the same level of "sent-ness" that Paul, Barnabas, and the early believers had. We must see ourselves as sent to someone. With that in mind, let's read and apply the text to our lives with joy and courage.

Read Acts 12:25-13:3

- What jumps out to you from the text?
- Who do you feel God has sent you to and why do you feel that he has?



This document can be used for either personal or group reflection.

Group facilitator: you do not need to ask every question but can select the best ones for your group dynamic.

- What would it feel like if you stepped out in faith to share the gospel with that person?
- Which of the following feels like the biggest obstacles that keeps you from going to those people? Please explain why.
