



# **ACTS 19:8-10**

"THE HALL"

OCTOBER 6, 2024

## SUMMARY

Pastor Joey highlighted that we talk about the things we love. From food to our family, they roll off our tongues with joy. But perplexingly, Jesus is hard to speak about—but not in the early church. This is worth our attention, as highlighted in a few powerful verses in the Book of Acts.

This week, Paul is in Ephesus, preaching, teaching, training, and empowering leaders to take the Gospel to the end of the earth. He has been there for two years, which is a lifetime in comparison to other portions we've examined. Paul is flexing and adapting himself around the stubborn Jewish hearts, and as a result, he ends up teaching in pagan areas where the Gospel grows across Asia.

Pastor Joey said this stint in Ephesus is notable not only for its length but also for its effectiveness. We should seek to learn from God's church planting strategy through Paul and implement it in our own lives.

The strategy is as follows:

- 1. Build Small Groups of Jesus Followers into connected, supported, self-sufficient groups that gather to sing, pray, read, and obey scripture.
- 2. Teach members of those groups to explain what new life in Jesus means so they can share it themselves within their spheres of influence.
- 3. Send those members out into the communities surrounding the church as everyday missionaries.

That's it. This is God's master plan for the church. It was effective then and is effective now if only we have the courage to pursue it. Together, let's examine this text and our hearts, seeking God and his ways to see the Gospel roll out of our tongues as we rub shoulders all through Indianapolis!



## DISCUSSION

As Pastor Joey emphasized, the church doesn't need more professional missionaries; it needs more everyday missionaries. The church was always meant to send its people out into the world, not merely be a place to invite people for staff to minister to them. As part of this community, each of us plays a crucial role in this mission.

• Why do you think the church in America is becoming more professionalized and consumer-oriented with fewer everyday missionaries?

Read the text: Acts 19:8-10

• What jumps out to you from the text?

Paul's stint in Ephesus is his longest and most effective. Pastor Joey said that if there is a model for church planting in the Book of Acts, this is it. Here is Paul's strategy:

- i.Build Small Groups of Jesus Followers into connected, supported, self-sufficient groups that gather to sing, pray, read, and obey scripture.
- ii. Teach members of that group of those groups to explain what new life in Jesus means so they can share it themselves with their sphere of influence.
- iii. Send those members out into the communities surrounding the church as everyday missionaries.
- iv. That's it. This is God's master plan for the church.
- Why do you believe this has been so effective in the history of the church?
- Paul mentioned that he ran up against stubborn hearts that resisted this call. Why do you think that was, and where do we still see that today in the church of the West?
- Which part of this strategy is missing in our church, and what should we do to remedy it?
