## A \$1.21M Capital Campaign

As we celebrated our 60th Anniversary as a church—and praise God for what he has done at and through Faith!—our leadership teams were hard at work identifying foundational investments necessary to propel us into the next decades of ministry.

Every person who calls Faith Church their home has the chance to invest in building Faith for the Future. By giving alongside a \$400,000 estate gift that we’ve already received, your investment will help make sure our building is in top notch condition, our leadership can set a visionary course for the future, and we can reach out to the community around us with the good news of new life in Jesus.

### Strategies | \$415k

Our ministry teams have identified key growth areas for the future of Faith Church: creating tools for congregants to use to reach their neighborhoods (\$15k), developing and releasing evangelism training and discipleship curriculum (\$35k), setting long-term vision and strategy through partnering with a church consulting group (\$65k), equipping and placing evangelistically-minded individuals in local apartment complexes to share Jesus with our Nora neighborhood (\$150k), and developing a pastoral residency partnership with Indianapolis Theological Seminary (\$150k).

### Spaces | \$800k

Our teams have identified approximately \$800,000 worth of needed investments in our facility: getting the humidity issues under control in the Worship Center (\$240k), replacing sound and lighting equipment in the Worship Center (\$180k), updating paint, carpet, and doors (\$200k), replacing worn-out furniture and toys (\$15k), remodeling parts of the building left out of the Ambassadors Project (\$85k), updating classroom technology (\$30k), installing new security measures (\$30k), and giving the missions house a refresh (\$20k).

### Plan

Our leadership won’t spend money we don’t have in hand, so our spending on spaces and strategies is dependent on our collective investment over the next few years. With congregational approval at the Celebration of Ministry on November 17th, we can move forward with a campaign launch in January and begin taking pledges.
