



# ACTS 27: 39-44

"THE SHIPWRECK"
JUNE 29, 2025

#### SUMMARY

Pastor Nathan brought closure to Paul's maritime saga. Paul, under the care and direction of the Master of the wind and the waves, adds temporary sea captain to his resume. Despite the hopeless situation surrounding him, he helped his Roman captors stay alive amid a shipwreck that could have meant certain death.

Looking beyond the story on the page, Pastor Nathan saw spiritual themes that help us all navigate the suffering and uncertainty life throws at us. Like Paul, we often find ourselves tossed by the storms of life and in need of an anchor. God's promises are the anchor that we must cling to, keeping us from going under the waves of despair.

But to properly use those promises, we must answer two questions:

1. What do God's promises do?

God's promises are essential gifts from God that anchor our souls, guide our lives, and secure our future.

2.What are God's promises?

Although God has given us numerous promises, Pastor Nathan highlighted three: God will strengthen us, He will keep us, and He will never leave us.

Amid the storms of life and our own doubt, we must return again and again to these essential questions and promises that anchor our soul. Together, let's unpack this text and savor these truths.

A promise is a declaration of assurance that one will do something sometime in the future. Therefore, with every promise, there is some period of waiting. In the waiting lie all the challenges we mortals have with promises.

- Which anchors do you believe Paul may have treasured the most and sustained him on his journey?
