GLOBAL OUTREACH

Kyiv Theological Seminary: Faculty actively developing courses/resources to equip students to serve in realities of war: providing both theological knowledge and forming mature followers of Christ who can lead others to Him and help them grow in the midst of hardship. Pray for those from KTS recently mobilized: Andrii Z (military chaplain), Andrii M (age 58, combat-related duties) as well as Vitaliy M, Edward B. and Shane P — for God's protection, health, strength, grace as they serve. Seminary facilities damaged by missile strike on 7/11/26 have been repaired; preparations are being made before winter arrives, a second generator purchased. Pray the Lord provides necessary resources for coming winter. Even in war/hardship many young people are dedicating their lives to ministry. 9/9

Middle East Bible Outreach (MEBO) and Arab Baptist Theological Seminary: Lebanon continues to be the center of pressures from refugee resettlement in the middle east increased from current war in Iran and conflict between Israel and Hezbollah. Pray for ministries of MEBO stretched thin to serve growing numbers.
